## Prostate Specific Antigen (PSA) and 25-Hydroxy Vitamin D

Please be reminded that as per Ministry of Health and Long Term Care guidelines, **the above tests are** <u>not</u> **OHIP insured services unless the patient meets certain eligibility criteria**, (Please refer to MOHLTC INFO Bulletin Number 4488 for PSA and Number 4522 for 25-Hydroxy Vitamin D).

You are encouraged to use the latest version of OHIP Laboratory Requisition Form (4422-84) (2013/01) (**see reverse**) to check the appropriate box(es) when ordering the above tests.

Older versions of the Laboratory Requisition Form may continue to be used, but the healthcare practitioner **MUST clearly indicate whether the PSA or 25-Hydroxy Vitamin D is insured or uninsured.** If this is not specified on the requisition, the testing laboratory will assume the test is uninsured and the patient will be responsible for payment to the laboratory service provider.

**Please note:** The laboratory will <u>NOT</u> be able to adjust the billing from uninsured to insured at a later date.
